



Flu Pandemic


- Occurs when a new Flu virus emerges
- And...
- 1) Little/No immunity in humans,
- 2) Spreads quickly and easily from person to person world wide,
- And
- 3) Causes serious illness or death


Seasonal vs Avian Flu

- Season Flu
- Respiratory illness transmitted person to person
- Vaccine available
- < 2K die in NC yearly



- Flu occurs naturally in wild birds
- H5N1 variant; deadly to fowl; transmitted from birds to human
- No immunity
- No vaccine
